

BULKY ITEM DROP OFF DAYS FOR CHAMBERSBURG BORO RESIDENTS

The Borough of Chambersburg will now be accepting bulky items at its facility on Dump Road located directly off of Hollywell Avenue (entrance across from the Thaddeus Stevens Elementary School) **beginning Monday, April 25, 2011 and continuing through Saturday, May 7, 2011, from 8:00 AM to 3:00 PM except Sundays.**

All borough residents, taking advantage of this opportunity to dispose of their bulky items, **will be required to provide photo identification** (such as a driver's license) prior to entering the facility. Additionally, anyone contracted to haul bulky items for a borough resident will be required to provide the name, address and phone number of the resident whose bulky items are being hauled. Please be aware that there will be a check in point located at the entrance of the facility where resident identification and hauler's information will be verified. Please be prepared to allow additional time for verification of ID. Anyone not providing proper identification will be refused entry to the facility. Entrance and exit to and from the drop off facility requires crossing (2) single lane bridges. Be prepared for the possibility of slight delays as traffic moves across the bridges.

Please call the Public Works Office at **261-3213**, Monday through Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM, with questions pertaining to the new bulky item drop off program as well as to obtain the names and phone numbers of possible haulers* (*the Borough does not endorse anyone on the hauling list).
