ELDER STREET CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULED

Please be advised that Fayetteville Contractors will soon begin construction work on the Elder Street Improvements Project.

The Elder Street Improvements Project will include storm sewer system improvements, curb and sidewalk installation, Full Depth Reclamation base course and standard asphalt wearing course to create a finished street surface. The multi-year project will be completed in phases, with the first phase being storm sewer system improvements that Fayetteville Contractors will complete no later than October 15, 2018. The project is funded with Community Development Block grants, with no cost to property owners with frontage onto Elder Street

Vehicle access will occasionally be restricted, with a Fayetteville Contractors flagging crew to properly direct vehicles through the construction site.

If you would like to learn more about the Elder Street Improvements Project please plan to attend a public meeting at Borough Hall on Thursday, May 3, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. The meeting will be held in Council Chambers on the second floor of Borough Hall, 100 S. Second St., Chambersburg, PA. You can talk with staff about the project and learn about how your property may be affected.
