To the Contract Documents for

RENOVATIONS TO FIRST FLOOR MALE EMS BUNKROOM/BATHROOM

In accordance with the requirements of the "Instructions to Bidders", this Addendum shall be attached to and become a part of the Contract Documents for the above referenced project.

1. Flooring

Page 20 of Bid Documents - Bathroom Portion Work - Section b) Flooring

Acceptable Alternative – A floating floor that is of the same grade is an acceptable alternative in the bathroom. LVP is also still acceptable. *Reason for alternative -Due to the possibility of asbestos tile/adhesive and possible delay in testing.

Page 20 of Bid Documents - Bunkroom Portion Work - Section a) Flooring

Acceptable Alternative – A floating floor that is of the same grade is an acceptable alternative in the bunkroom. LVP is also still acceptable.

*Reason for alternative - Due to the possibility of asbestos tile/adhesive and possible delay in testing.

2. Counters/Vanity

Page 20 of Bid Documents – Bathroom Portion Work - Section C) counter/vanity

It was determined that the project indeed does fall under ADA on items that are replaced. This would affect the countertops/storage vanity.

Update – The countertop/vanity must meet ADA compliance. Minimal storage would still be requested, but it is understandable that this may not be feasible.

3. Shower

Page 20 of Bid Documents - Bathroom Portion Work - Section f) shower

The question was asked instead of a built-in shower unit if the shower could be retiled?

Acceptable Alternative – The shower may be re-tiled and appropriately sized for 1 person or the one-person fiberglass shower unit is also acceptable.

*Reason for alternative – Requests from bidder

4. ADA Compliance - Confirmation

It was determined that the project would need to be ADA compliant on items that would be replaced/updated.

This would affect the following: Urinal, Toilet Partition, Shower, and counter/vanity.
