Gas Technician Apprentice

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities: Must have and maintain a valid Commonwealth of Pennsylvania motor vehicle operator's license, 3 years clean driving history, and be insurable in the independent opinion of the Borough's motor vehicle insurance underwriter, in order to be eligible for this position. Physical condition will permit activities including, but not limited to lifting 50 lbs., stooping, driving and working under severely adverse conditions and temperatures. Experience with a backhoe is preferable. Establish and maintain good working relationships with those contacted in the course of work. Should have two or more years experience in the plumbing, heating, underground utility construction and or natural gas field. Must have CDL license or obtain within six months of employment. Subject to random drug and alcohol testing.

Minimum Requirements:

1. Must not have any disciplinary action (written reprimand or suspension) in their file during the preceding two years.
2. Must have and maintain a valid Commonwealth of Pennsylvania motor vehicle operator's license, 3 years clean driving history, and be insurable in the independent opinion of the Borough's motor vehicle insurance underwriter, in order to be eligible for this position.
3. Must have and retain CDL license or obtain within six months of employment.
4. Must be in good physical condition due to frequent digging with a shovel and moderate lifting and handling of tools, equipment and materials.
5. Must have over 2 years experience in underground utility construction, the gas industry or equivalent, i.e. plumbing and heating.
6. Must be willing to take training to develop knowledge and skills regarding equipment operation and gas industry.
7. Must be able to qualify to DOT/OPS OQ requirements.

METHOD OF SELECTION:

1. Employees working for the Borough of Chambersburg will be considered first;
2. If a Borough employee does not fill the position, outside persons will be considered in accordance with the Borough's Equal Employment Opportunity Policy. Preference will be given for Borough residents and nonuser of tobacco products.
3. Must not have had any disciplinary action (written or suspension) in file during preceding two years.
