

ORDINANCE NO. 2017- _____

**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE
BOROUGH OF CHAMBERSBURG, CHAPTER 286
THEREOF, ENTITLED VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC**

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Town Council of the Borough of Chambersburg, as follows:

SECTION NO 1. Legislative Findings To more efficiently regulate motor vehicle parking on Borough streets, the following revisions to Section 286-25 of the Code of the Borough entitled "Parking prohibited at all times in certain locations" is revised to provide as follows:

- A. Currently parking is prohibited on both sides of Liberty Street between Third Street and the Railroad Highline. The change will allow parking on the north side of the referenced section of Liberty Street and will read as follows:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Liberty Street	South	Third Street and Railroad Highline

- B. Currently there are conflicting provisions for parking on Washington Street between Third Street and East Point Avenue, one provision prohibiting parking on the South side of Washington Street and a second provision prohibiting parking on both sides of Washington Street. The regulation will be revised to allow parking along the section of Washington Street between Third and Sixth Street to be alternated from one side to the other on an annual basis. It will provide as follows:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>
Washington Street	Alternately on an Annual basis	Third Street and Sixth Street

SECTION NO. 2. The following shall be **ADDED TO** Article III, Parking Regulations, Section 286-31, Special Purpose Parking Zones Established:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Location</u>	<u>Authorized Purpose or vehicle</u>
W. Catherine Street	South	area of 106	Handicapped person or disabled veteran's

vehicle *

Fairground Avenue North area of 613 Handicapped person
or disabled veteran's

SECTION NO. 3. The following shall be **ADDED TO** Article II, Traffic Regulations, Section 286.25, Parking Prohibited at all Times in Certain Locations:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<u>Hours</u>
Fourth Street	East	Curbline and 20 feet South of Elm Avenue	At all times
Scotland Avenue	East	Curbline and 20 feet South of Belvedere Court	At all times
South Street	South	Black Avenue and Hollywell Avenue	At all times

SECTION NO. 4. The following shall be **ADDED TO** Article III, Parking Regulations, Section 286.10, One Way Highways Established:

<u>Highway</u>	<u>From</u>	<u>To</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Columbia Court	Private Alley Rear of 454 Norland Avenue	Ramsey Avenue	South

SECTION NO. 5. The following shall be **ADDED TO** Article III, Parking Regulations, Section 286.14, Stop Intersections Established:

<u>Stop Highway</u>	<u>Through Highway</u>	<u>Direction of Travel</u>
Mill Road	Orchard Drive	East and West
Orchard Drive	Mill Road	North and South

SECTION NO. 6. In all other respects, Chapter 286 of the Code of the Borough of Chambersburg shall be and remain in full force and effect.

SECTION NO. 7. Saving Clause. Nothing in this Ordinance shall be constructed to affect any suit or proceedings pending in any court, or any rights acquired, or liability incurred or any cause or causes of action acquired or existing, under any ordinance hereby revised or otherwise affected by this Ordinance, nor shall any just or legal right or remedy of any character be lost, impaired or affected by this Ordinance.

SECTION NO. 8. Severability: The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any of its sections, clauses or sentences shall be held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such provision shall not affect or impair any remaining sections, clauses or sentences of the same.

SECTION NO. 9. Effective Date: This Ordinance shall take effect on January 23, 2017.
