All applicants will need to get a score of at least 70% on the written exam to take the second part of the testing process which is the physical agility test (a pass/fail test). Physical agility testing information is included within the application packet.

ELIGIBILITY EXAMINATION FOR POSITION OF POLICE OFFICER IN THE CHAMBERSBURG POLICE DEPARTMENT

The purpose of the examination is to develop an eligibility listing for the position of Police Officer in the event of a vacancy. Veterans will be given preference in accordance with law.

You must be 18 years of age or older, in good physical condition, of good moral character and must pass a written examination and a physical agility test to be placed on the eligibility list.

You must be a high school graduate or have equivalent experience or training.

You must reside within 15 air miles of the Borough of Chambersburg prior to completion of your probationary period and continue within that range thereafter while you are employed.

You'll start at \$51,750.40 annually (2017) and have the opportunity for advancement increases up to a maximum for Patrolman XI of \$68,140.80 annually (2017). Promotion to higher ranks could earn you more.

Opportunities may be available for a fluent Bilingual English-Spanish Police Officer Appointment should one become available. If such positions are available, the applicant will indicate on their application that they are fluent in both Spanish and English.

PHYSICAL AGILITY TEST

WILL BE HELD EITHER APRIL 19, 2017 OR APRIL 20, 2017

If you pass the Written Exam, you will be informed, along with your score, of the exact date of the Physical Agility Testing. These are minimum standards for all applicants. This is a pass/fail test. Failure on two (2) of the tests will result in the applicant being disqualified.

- 1. Pushing a vehicle for a distance of nineteen (19) feet using a standard vehicle.
- 2. Obstacle run covering 600 yards with six, four (4) foot obstacles in three (3) minutes.
- 3. <u>Sitting shotput throwing a nine (9) pound ball for a distance of 125 inches.</u>
- 4. Wall climb going up and over a wall from a "full hang position".
- 5. <u>Long distance run/walk</u> covering 1.5 miles must be completed in the following times:

If you pass the Chambersburg Police Department Written Exam and the Agility Test, move forward in the hiring process, and are offered a police officer position you will be required to pass additional physical agility testing to enter the HACC police academy. The testing and standards for those tests are available on the following website www.mpoetc.state.pa.us. Look at Officer Certification and then physical fitness chart and physical fitness protocols. It explains the testing and the standards you must attain.

- 1. Running for several hundred yards or more;
- 2. Climbing over walls and other obstacles;
- 3. Crawling;
- Pushing motor vehicles;
- 5. Pulling or carrying accident, fire or crime victims;
- 6. Using physical force to apprehend and subdue arrestees;
- 7. Withstanding prolonged exposure, as long as eight hours, to extreme weather conditions:
- 8. Withstanding prolonged periods of standing and sitting;

- Withstanding frequent exposure to stress-producing situations such as encountering persons injured or killed by accidents, crimes or suicide;
- 10. Dealing with domestic disputes;
