The Chambersburg Aquatic Center 2020:

It is the Department's goal to open the facility as scheduled, on Saturday, **May 23, 2020**. As such, staff will continue to work to accomplish this task unless informed otherwise. We encourage you to continue to purchase memberships at the discounted rate of 10% off the standard membership rate prior to May 23. Should plans be altered, the Department will extend fair and equitable reimbursement options.
